We have been given a remarkably generous challenge grant from the Sands Family Supporting Foundation that will match every \$1.00 we raise in the coming year with \$1.50!

Experiential Learning Activities


This year, all our students have taken part in a cross-curricular study of the Erie Canal. Activities beyond the classroom have included riding on the Sam Patch and going through a lock, hearing from a tug boat captain, and creating a historical mural in an NHS corridor.

This kind of experiential learning supports our students' growth – academically and socially. These activities require school funds and, in most cases, also require our families to help cover the costs. But, some of our families simply don't have the financial resources to allow their children to participate. We'd ensure that all kids can participate in these programs, as well as give us an opportunity to expand learning activities we can offer.

1:1 iPad Initiative

Using iPads in our classrooms improves communication, helps students organize their work, provides collaborative content creation opportunities, provides educational efficiencies, and makes learning more engaging. We began this initiative 3 years ago. All our students in grades 8 - 10 have a tablet. We hope to expand the initiative in the coming year to include all 11th and 12th graders.

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Professional and Curriculum Development

One of our greatest assets is our faculty and professional staff. Over the last year, we have been able to support a wide range of professional learning opportunities on topics ranging from technology in the classroom to how the role of executive functioning impacts student learning and behavior. We also support teachers with resources to create new curriculum over the summer. This past year, one of our teachers developed a new Personal Finance Class to teach our 11th graders about financial planning with real life examples.

We would love to be able to support more professional and curriculum development in the coming year.
